STEP System FAQ

Much of Rutherford County rests on limestone rock, which doesn't easily absorb water. A STEP field (Septic Tank Effluent Pump) uses gravity and naturally occurring substances (rocks, sand, and dirt) – along with UV light – to absorb and treat wastewater.

Tennessee's Growth Spurt Continues

We all know how dense the traffic is getting in Rutherford County. To really understand the monumental growth, though, it's helpful to see data from the county and the state (information courtesy of the <u>U.S. Census Bureau</u> and the state <u>Comptroller of the Treasury</u>).



- For the first time ever, Tennessee has topped 7 million in population.
- Tennessee is now the 15th most populous state in America.
- From 2020-2022, Tennessee took in 140,553 new residents.
- Since 2020, Rutherford County is the 43rd fastest-growing county in the nation. For reference, there are 3,243 counties in America.
- Rutherford County is currently the fastest growing of all 95 counties in the state.

Updates on Capital Improvements

The following provides the latest about progress on major projects in the county. As for why we use ductile iron and PVC pipe, we have a webpage for that topic.



Baker Road Water Main Replacement

As of 6-30-23, the remaining project clean up was completed. This brings the total quantities to approximately 10,300 feet of 20-inch, 40 feet of 12-inch, 650 feet of 8-inch, and 450 feet of 6-inch water mains, plus 19 fire hydrants and 57 valves.

South Loop Phase 1 (West Segment - Parsons Road, Miller Johnson Road & Christiana)

As of 6-30-23, approximately 200 feet of 1-inch service lines were installed,

plus 14 service reconnections, and a portion of the project cleanup were completed. This brings the total quantities installed to approximately 9,000 feet of 16-inch, 7,900 feet of 12-inch, 6,100 feet of 8-inch, and 3,800 feet of 6-inch water mains, plus 36 fire hydrants and 77 valves.

South Loop Phase 2 (East Segment - Miller Johnson Road, Woodfin Road, and Sledge Road)

As of 6-30-23, approximately 2,600 feet of 16-inch, 40 feet of 8-inch, and 70 feet of 6-inch water mains were installed along Sledge Road and Highway 231, plus 2 fire hydrants and 10 valves. This brings the total quantities installed to approximately 19,200 feet of 16-inch, 40 feet of 8-inch, and 220 feet of 6-inch water mains, plus 18 fire hydrants and 47 valves.

Berkshire Subdivision Water System Improvements

As of 6-30-23, the project was 28% complete and on schedule. Approximately 730 feet of 1-inch service lines were installed and 16 service reconnections were completed on the western (Blackman Road) side of the project. This brings the total quantities installed to approximately 2,200 feet of 1-inch service lines and 2 fire hydrant check valves. Plus 70 service reconnections have been completed.

Much of our work falls into three categories: water quality, maintenance of infrastructure, and support of residential and commercial growth. That said, here are some key statistics related to CUD's efforts.
